

3.10 The most significant individual awards for R&D&I: representative examples FFPW

- 1) CENAKVA ranked fourth (2014) and fifth (2016) out of 48 newly established Centres supported by the Operational Program Research and Development for Innovations. Three centres including CENAKVA ranked “A” in the evaluation of the National Program of Sustainability I. evaluating twelve centres. Following the evaluation in 2017 (58 Centres involved), CENAKVA was newly included on the Roadmap of Large Research Infrastructures in the Czech Republic.
- 2) FFPW repeatedly ranked first in the survey of Týden magazine which focused on the evaluation of studying opportunities at universities in the country. FFPW listed in a category of Natural Sciences in 2016 and Agricultural, Forestry and Veterinary Sciences later on.
- 3) prof. Zdeňka Svobodová was awarded the Milada Paulová Award in the field of Agricultural Sciences for a life-long scientific achievement by a female scientist.
- 4) Dr. Jacky Cosson received a medal of the National Center for Scientific Research as a recognition for his whole scientific career.
- 5) Dr. Bořek Drozd and Assoc. Prof. Petr Hartvich co-authored a book titled “Biology and Protection of Lampreys” (published in the FFPW USB edition), which received a prestigious Josef Hlávka Award.
