## Submission Guidelines || Manuscript submission

Authors are invited to submit original, unpublished manuscripts that are not under consideration elsewhere. Manuscripts must be submitted in Microsoft Word (.docx) format.

### Length and structure

- 1 Recommended length: 6,000–9,000 words (excluding references, tables, and figures)
- 2 Abstract: 150–250 words
- 3 Keywords: 4–6 keywords
- 4 Standard structure: Introduction, Literature Review, Methods, Results, Discussion, Conclusion

### Formatting requirements

- 1 File format: Microsoft Word (.docx)
- 2 Font: Times New Roman, 12 pt
- 3 Line spacing: 1.5 or double
- 4 Margins: 2.5 cm (1 inch)
- 5 Text alignment: left-aligned
- 6 Keep formatting simple; final layout will follow publisher guidelines

### Figures and tables

- 1 Figures and tables should be referenced in the text
- 2 Low-resolution versions may be embedded for review
- 3 High-quality figures must be submitted separately
- 4 Accepted formats: PNG, JPEG, TIFF
- 5 Minimum resolution: 300 dpi
- 6 Large files can be shared via file-sharing services

### References

Use a consistent citation style. APA 7th edition is recommended. Ensure all cited works appear in the reference list.

### Submission process

Submit your manuscript as a .docx file via e-mail: [ecoculturalheritage@jcu.cz](mailto:ecoculturalheritage@jcu.cz). Large supplementary files can be shared via file-sharing links.

### Publication

Selected papers will be considered for publication in the new Taylor & Francis journal 'Science, Heritage and Technology', with the first issue planned for early 2027 under the KreativEU Alliance.

### Notes

All submissions will undergo peer review. Editors may request revisions, formatting adjustments, or shortening. Final acceptance is conditional upon meeting journal requirements.
