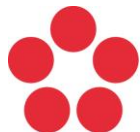

Applicants from public universities can use three types of mobility: study stays, summer schools and summer language courses. Study stays can last up to one academic year, exceptionally for the duration of the entire study. <p>AKTION Czech Republic – Austria</p>	<p>Scholarships are intended for students of Master's and Doctoral degree programmes in order to work on their graduation or dissertation thesis. Students of all disciplines can apply for financial support. They can also participate in short professional excursions or summer schools. These provide a great opportunity to gain new experience, establish professional contacts and improve the ability to speak a foreign language. Copernicus	COPERNICUS is an association for the promotion of Eastern European, Central European and Central Asian students. Each semester, students are provided a grant to visit Hamburg. Here they study one semester at a local university and then complete a two-to-three-month internship in a company, organization or public authority. Accommodation is mostly provided in host families. The required level of German is B2 or C1.
