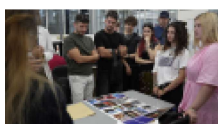

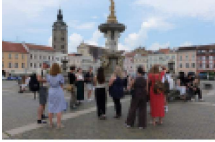
KreativEU National Student Festival at the University of Greifswald

On June 26 and 27, 2026, the first KreativEU National Student Festival at the University of Greifswald took place. Read on to find out more about this exciting event!



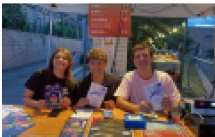
KreativEU Summer School Brings Heritage to Life through Creative and International Learning

From 29 June to 10 July 2026, the Polytechnic University of Tomar hosted the first KreativEU Educational Summer School, entitled Art & Heritage in Motion: From Theory to Practice. The initiative brought together 28 participants from six European institutions in an international programme combining cultural heritage, the arts, conservation and restoration, digital technologies, sustainability and creativity.
