DEGREE PROGRAMMES

Agriculture

- ♥ Within this field, we offer the doctoral degree programme **Fishery** that enhances scientific knowledge and prepares students for a future scientific, research, or pedagogical career at higher education or research institutions as well as for positions in top-level management in enterprises or public authorities.

Biology, ecology and the environment

- ♥ Within this field, we offer the doctoral degree programme **Protection of Aquatic Ecosystems** that develops scientific findings oriented towards the studies of contamination of the aquatic environment and the ecology of aquatic organisms.

Combined fields of education

- ♥ In master's studies, we offer the multi-disciplinary degree programme **Fishery and Protection of Waters** covering both fields i) agriculture and ii) biology, ecology and the environment. The studies particularly enhance knowledge of special fish farming, reproduction, and breeding of fish, water source protection, management of open waters, environmental conservation, and aspects of contamination of the aquatic environment. The studies are suitable for graduates of biologically or agriculturally oriented bachelor's fields.

The faculty and its people

♥ The Faculty of Fisheries and Protection of Waters educates around 180 to 220 students in total, of which 50–60 are doctoral students. More than 10% of our employees and 60% of our doctoral students are foreigners. Unique in the central European context, the faculty has a number of technologically advanced facilities in 3 locations across South Bohemia.

Student support

♥ Our doctoral students (full-time) are awarded scholarships and contracts of employment representing in total an income of EUR 700–1000/month (i.e. EUR 8 400/year or more) depending on performance and study results. On top of that, the faculty also offers subsidised accommodation and students may also receive additional scholarships with respect to various significant study, research, international, or social activities.

Living costs and tuition

♥ Living costs in Czechia are half of those in Western countries, but the education is comparable and equal to the top EU standards. Foreign doctoral students pay a tuition fee of about EUR 20/year. The tuition fee for master's studies is EUR 500/year.



APPLICATIONS AND ADMISSIONS:

SUBMITTING APPLICATIONS

Applications should be submitted electronically via the USB e-application system.

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

- ♥ Applicants for admission to master's and doctoral studies are generally admitted based on rankings compiled by an admission committee. The criteria include the admission test or interview results and the information provided in the documents submitted with the application.
- ♥ The admission procedures for doctoral degree programmes are usually held twice a year, and once a year for master's degree programmes.
- ♥ Specific rules governing applications and conditions for admission procedures are stipulated by an ordinance of the Dean.
