APPLICATIONS AND ADMISSIONS:

SUBMITTING APPLICATIONS

Application submission takes place online on the website.

Application submission deadline:

- ◆ for bachelor's degree programmes: March 31 (on an annual basis),
- ◆ for the consecutive master's degree programmes: mid-May and end of October,
- ◆ for doctoral degree programmes: mid-January and mid-May.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Completed full secondary/secondary vocational education for bachelor's programmes and bachelor's or master's degree for consecutive master's or doctoral programmes. The fee for the admission procedure is 700 CZK. For admission to cross-border programmes it is necessary to take the entrance examination in English.

ADMISSION EXAMINATION DATES

Admission examinations always take place in early February, late May and early June in the given year.
