criteria	Excellence (50%): (1) Quality and pertinence of the project's research and innovation objectives (and the extent to which they are ambitious, and go beyond the state of the art); (2) Soundness of the proposed methodology (including interdisciplinary approaches, consideration of the gender dimension and other diversity aspects if relevant for the research project, and the quality of open science practices); (3) Quality of the supervision, training and of the two-way transfer of knowledge between the researcher and the host; (4) Quality and appropriateness of the researcher's professional experience, competences and skills.
	Impact (30%): (5) Credibility of the measures to enhance the career perspectives and employability of the researcher and contribution to his/her skills development; (6) Suitability and quality of the measures to maximise expected outcomes and impacts, as set out in the dissemination and exploitation plan, including communication activities; (7) The magnitude and importance of the project's contribution to the expected scientific, societal and economic impacts.
Conditions & restrictions	Implementation (20%): (8) Quality and effectiveness of the work plan, assessment of risks and appropriateness of the effort assigned to work packages; (9) Quality and capacity of the host institutions and participating organisations, including hosting arrangements. >> Applicants must be postdoctoral researchers at the date of the call deadline (14 Sep 2022), i.e. in a possession of a doctoral degree. Applicants who have successfully defended their doctoral thesis but who have not yet formally been awarded the doctoral degree will also be considered as postdoctoral researchers and will be considered eligible to apply. >> At the call deadline (14 Sep 2022), applicants must have a maximum of 8 years full-time equivalent experience in research, measured from the date of award of the doctoral degree. Years of experience outside research and career breaks (e.g. due to parental leave), will not count towards the amount of research experience. For nationals or long-term residents of EU MS or HE AC who wish to reintegrate to pursue their research career in EU MS or HE AC, years of experience in research in third countries will not be considered in the above maximum. >> Recruited researchers must comply with the following mobility rule: they must not have resided or carried out their main activity (work, studies, etc.) in the country of the beneficiary (for European Postdoctoral Fellowships), or the host organisation for the outgoing phase (for Global Postdoctoral Fellowships) for more than 12 months in the 36 months immediately before the call deadline (14 Sep 2022). >> Researchers wishing to reintegrate from a third country must either be based in a third country at the call deadline (14 Sep 2022), or have moved directly from a third country to an EU MS or HE AC within the last 12 months before the call deadline (14 Sep 2022). >> An additional period of up to 6 months at the end of the project can be awarded to researchers who will spend that period in a non-academic organisation established in an EU MS or HE AC.

	within the overall duration of their fellowship in any country worldwide. The secondment phase can be a single period or be divided into shorter mobility periods. Secondments cannot exceed one third of the standard fellowship duration and should be in line with the project objectives, adding significant value and impact to the fellowship. >> The ERA Fellowships (ERA-PF) scheme will fund proposals submitted to the MSCA-2022-PF call with a beneficiary located in a Widening Country but which failed to score highly enough to receive funding under this call. Only European Postdoctoral Fellowships can qualify for the ERA-PF call. Applicants can only be considered for this additional funding opportunity by ticking "YES" to the question "Do you wish to participate to the ERA Postdoctoral Fellowships and thus increase your chances of being funded?" in the application form. >> Seals of Excellence will be awarded to applications with a total score equal to or higher than 85%, but which cannot be funded due to lack of budget available to the call. >> MSCA PF proposals submitted under Horizon Europe and having received a score of less than 70% must not be resubmitted the following year. >> The beneficiary must employ and supervise the researcher during the action.
