Applicant	Postdocs (European nationals or long-term residents) up to 8 years since completion of PhD (PhD received after 14 Sep 2014 + maternity leave of 18 months per child born after the PhD award date) who move or have moved from any MS/AC country to a non-associated Third Country.

Evaluation criteria	<p>Single-stage evaluation process.</p> <p>Excellence (50%): (1) Quality and pertinence of the project's research and innovation objectives (and the extent to which they are ambitious, and go beyond the state of the art); (2) Soundness of the proposed methodology (including interdisciplinary approaches, consideration of the gender dimension and other diversity aspects if relevant for the research project, and the quality of open science practices); (3) Quality of the supervision, training and of the two-way transfer of knowledge between the researcher and the host; (4) Quality and appropriateness of the researcher's professional experience, competences and skills.</p> <p>Impact (30%): (5) Credibility of the measures to enhance the career perspectives and employability of the researcher and contribution to his/her skills development; (6) Suitability and quality of the measures to maximise expected outcomes and impacts, as set out in the dissemination and exploitation plan, including communication activities; (7) The magnitude and importance of the project's contribution to the expected scientific, societal and economic impacts.</p> <p>Implementation (20%): (8) Quality and effectiveness of the work plan, assessment of risks and appropriateness of the effort assigned to work packages; (9) Quality and capacity of the host institutions and participating organisations, including hosting arrangements.</p>
Conditions & restrictions	<p>>> Applicants must be postdoctoral researchers at the date of the call deadline (14 Sep 2022), i.e. in a possession of a doctoral degree. Applicants who have successfully defended their doctoral thesis but who have not yet formally been awarded the doctoral degree will also be considered as postdoctoral researchers and will be considered eligible to apply.</p> <p>>> At the call deadline (14 Sep 2022), applicants must have a maximum of 8 years full-time equivalent experience in research, measured from the date of award of the doctoral degree. Years of experience outside research and career breaks (e.g. due to parental leave), will not count towards the amount of research experience.</p> <p>>> Recruited researchers must comply with the following mobility rule: they must not have resided or carried out their main activity (work, studies, etc.) in the host organisation for the outgoing phase (for Global Postdoctoral Fellowships) for more than 12 months in the 36 months immediately before the call deadline (14 Sep 2022).</p> <p>>> Researchers going to a third country (Global Postdoctoral Fellowship) or researchers who wish to reintegrate to Europe, must be nationals or long-term residents (a period of legal and continuous residence of at least five consecutive years) EU MS or HE AC.</p> <p>>> An additional period of up to 6 months at the end of the project can be awarded to researchers who will spend that period in a non-academic organisation established in an EU MS or HE AC. In case of an optional non-academic placement, the associated partner must provide an up-to-date letter of commitment, to be submitted with the application, confirming their precise role and active participation in the proposal.</p> <p>>> Applications are made jointly by the researcher and the beneficiary (supervisor).</p> <p>>> Only one proposal per individual researcher can be submitted. In case of several proposals involving the same individual researcher, only the last submitted one will be considered eligible.</p> <p>>> If proposals with the same research objectives and work plan are submitted for different researchers, only the first submitted one will be considered eligible.</p> <p>>> One supervisor can be involved in more than one proposal in the same call.</p> <p>>> Applications must be submitted by a single independent legal entity, established in an EU MS or HE AC.</p> <p>>> Researchers receiving a Postdoctoral Fellowship may opt to include a secondment phase,</p>

	<p>within the overall duration of their fellowship in any country worldwide. The secondment phase can be a single period or be divided into shorter mobility periods. Secondments cannot exceed one third of the outgoing phase and should be in line with the project objectives, adding significant value and impact to the fellowship. Secondments cannot take place during the mandatory 12 month return period to the host organisation in a MS or AC.</p> <p>>> A maximum of 3 months can be spent at the start of the project at the beneficiary (or any other organisation mentioned in the description of the action), allowing the researcher to spend time there before going to the associated partner in the Third Country.</p> <p>>> In case of an optional non-academic placement, the associated partner must provide an up-to-date letter of commitment, to be submitted with the application, confirming their precise role and active participation in the proposal.</p> <p>>> Seals of Excellence will be awarded to applications with a total score equal to or higher than 85%, but which cannot be funded due to lack of budget available to the call.</p> <p>>> MSCA PF proposals submitted under Horizon Europe and having received a score of less than 70% must not be resubmitted the following year.</p> <p>>> The beneficiary must employ and supervise the researcher during the action.</p>
