<sup>1</sup> persons who have been vaccinated against Covid-19 in the Czech Republic, Slovakia, Germany, Austria, Poland, Hungary, Slovenia and Croatia do not have the obligation to undergo test and do not have the limitation of the free movement after the arrival, while travelling from the EU+ countries with medium and high risk

<sup>2</sup> it is not possible to travel to these countries at the moment

<sup>3</sup> citizens of Czechia and their family members with a residence permit, EU+ citizens with a certificate of temporary residence and foreigners with a permanent residence permit who use an individual transportation for their travel to Czechia, may replace required test before the departure with an antigen or a PCR test undregone within 5 days after the arrival

<sup>4</sup> this does not apply to the citizens of Czechia and their family members with a residence permit, EU+ citizens with a certificate of temporary residence and foreigners with a permanent residence permit **who use an individual transportation for their travel to Czechia** 

<sup>5</sup> citizens of Czechia and their family members with a residence permit, EU+ citizens with a certificate of temporary residence and foreigners with a permanent residence permit **may have antigen test not older than 24 hours instead of PCR test**
